Beltline Clean-up - We will see part of the "Model Mile" run through the Westview neighborhood. Sign-up sheets were passed out to volunteer for the October 20th "Model Mile" cleanup. Construction of paths and green spaces will begin in January 2008 and will also feature an arboretum. Additionally we have received a 5-year commitment from Trees Atlanta to keep the Beltline passage clear of kudzu.

Morehouse Revitalization Task Force - Gwen Cain informed us that the MRTF will provide WCO with a new intern. She also said that she will try to get more funding for the calling post.

Atlanta Funded Home Repair – Scott Smith is working to get aid to some senior citizens in need of minor home improvements and enhancements that are not capable of doing the repairs on their own.

Beautification Committee – The Beautification Committee announced the removal and cleaning out of old plants at Ontario and Abernathy Parks at 2:00pm on October 12. Residents were able to pick up old plants at that time.
