Audrey Baptiste stated that we need a list of the types of businesses we want in our community. Scott agreed and said a committee would be needed to do this.

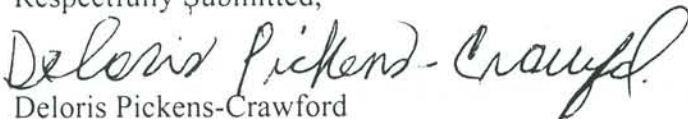
