Main Meeting

Approval of Minutes

No minutes printed out to review.

Police / Public Safety

Sgt. Bunyan is here. Stats compared to last year. :

- Homicides percentage is good.
- Rape: 0%
- Bugrlaries: up 200%. Actual number is 2. Last year was 0.
- Residentail burglaries: down 63%.
- Vehicle larcenies: up 700%. Last year had 1, this year have 8.
- Larcenices from vehicles: down 20%.
- Auto theft: up 100%.

He just came from zone 6. In zone 6, didn't have the kind of energy and camaraderie they have here. Zone 4 is very large. As a supervisor, Sgt. Bunyan is also answering calls.

There are a lot of young officers. He knows the first response can be long. But most of the officers that police this area are not from here. They came here. So they have to bring up addresses on GPS. And sometimes just driving there takes 10 minutes. Once all factors are taken into account, it can be 15+ minutes to get to the call. Once they do show up, though, he asks that his officers be able to handle the call rather than being abused and yelled at.

They are starting a new traffic unit starting yesterday. That should help with people not being able to commit crimes without any police presence. But they are only on duty for particular hours (12pm to 8pm). And criminals know those hours too.

Remember: call something in as soon as you see it. Second, secure yourself. Don't leave items in the vehicle.

J Scott brought up sky firing and the reports he has made. How can we get some action on that? Who can we speak to?

Sgt. Bunyan has the same question about why they don't have more units operating at night.

Youth program. In existence for 12 years. Have had some national exposure. Have been in Westview/West End since 2013.

We are in the process of making a movie. It's an HIV awareness movie. GA State has done a lot of research. Found that 30310 has the highest rate of infection in the city of Atlanta. Since 2010, 50% of newest infections are among teenagers. A goal is to empower young people. They are very smart, but they don't take HIV seriously.

The movie will focus on a young man actually dealing with the reality of living with HIV, from finding out he has it to dealing with the ramifications.

Here tonight because they want to do the filming in this community. They want to recruit young people to be part of the filiming. Will be working on a promotional video in the next week. Hoping to get some funding and get the movie into movie theaters, not just on DVD.

Looking for young people from 12 to 18, for positions in front of and behind the camera. There is no charge to be involved. And right now we are only looking for extras; the main characters have been selected. The information will go

out as soon as they are ready to start finding additional people. Right now the focus is on the promotional video. So far have raised enough money to get through casting and do some initial preparation work.

Proctor Creek watershed basin is one of the sites picked by the EPA. Mayors and urban leaders noted that urban communities need to be more involved in the environmental movement. Proctor Creek watershed basin is in West Atlanta.

That urban watershed basin "deserves to have a shot at housing opportunities to look at how waters have been backed up, how flooding has increased since the build up downtown". Various developments have created impervious surfaces, causing issues with the Chatahoochee.

Al is one of the people selected to come out and interact with the communities. Includes 9 partner NPUs and 4 connected NPUs. 38 connected community organizations and 9 connected community organizations. Kicked this off 5/1.

Looking for various leaders in the commuity to deliver their commuication and translate that into public policy.

What is the immediate impact on the neighborhoods around here? Atlanta has not done an assessment about 9 point source funding. They know how it comes off a building, but not how it runs through the street. An immediate assessment to get that data affects us because we don't have it available.

Time frame for the effort: between May 1st and November 30th. 7 round table discussions, a townhall meeting, and a community forum. Will get a letter requesting our community organization to host a town hall meeting or round table meeting.

Cleta Winslow is here to discuss the facade improvement on the store along RDA. Ali Carter joined in to explain. They will be doing permanent facade improvements along there.

Clint showed the facade. New windows, double doors, concrete wall along the bottom, aluminum siding. Will also put an awning at Westview Pizza. Will repaint the Westview storefront as well. Have arranged for that awning to be permanent as well.

Steffi: Currently there is a section that comes in.

Clint: That section will stay. Where you have a couple of doors with a block in between, now you'll have glass windows and a door.

Motion to approve the plans, leave them there and ex: Bruce moves, Sherry seconds the motion. 33 ayes, 0 nays, 1 abstention.

Cleta discussed some legislation related to West End. Patrick Berry pointed out that while we have been discussing that for a long time, we should have our own effort on rezoning rather than tagging onto West End's legislation. Cleta agreed; felt like they shouldn't try to include Westview, because we may have different stipulations.

Cleta is also honorary chariperson for West End Arts and Jazz Festival. Any artists that want to participate, there is a meeting at Star Theater in West End on 5/16. On the 17th of May at the Wren's Nest, some jazz artists will be there (2pm till 7pm). Cost of the tickets is between \$20 and \$25.
